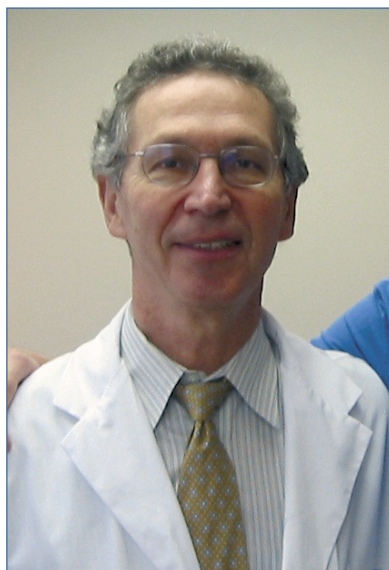


Jack Stein
